Note: The disagreements between these field notes and the location certificates of the Charley Boy, Beetha and Gem Lodes respectively with regard to the position of the discovery cuts and shaft are due to errors in the latter.

Report.

The Corner of Secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, T 7 N, R 26 E, M. 10. B. & M., is a trap stone 8 ins. by 8 ins. in cross section showing 6 ins. out of the ground marked one notch on South edge and five notches on the east edge, with a small mound of stones surrounding it. This was the nearest corner that could be found as considerable time was spent tracing out the ones further up into the hills and closer to the claims.

In giving the intersections to the section line between Secs. 5 & 6, I assumed the course and distance for that line to be correct as it was originally run out.

All the location monuments of the Lodes of this Survey are of stone, 4 ft. in diameter at the base, and 4 ft. high. In each monument is placed a notice giving the name of the Lode, Date of location, the general course of the Lode, each way and also the width on each side, and the names of the locators.

All the location corners were marked by a stake and monument 4 ft. high the stake having the description of the corner marked on it.
