ROBERTS PLACER.

Beginning at Cor. No. 1.
Identical with quartzite rock believed to be the N.E. Cor.
Sec. 36, T. 9 N., R. 45 E., M.D.M., 5x9x12 ins., with
mound of rock, but no apparent chisel marks, whence

Witness corner to Cor. No. 1 of said placer, a pine post
4x6 ins., showing 18 ins. above a mound of stone and earth,
scribed WC-R-1-4229, bears S.3°11'W. 10.2 ft.

A cedar stake 3 ins. in diameter, 3 ft. above ground,
bearing on E. face a steel sign marked "National Forest
Boundary," bears S.1°16'E. 3.5 ft.

The higher of the two brick smoke stacks at the Combina-
tion Mill bears N.39°42'30"W. 1395.8 ft.

Thence S.3°11'W.

small mound of rock, whence

Witness corner to Cor. No. 2, a pine post 4x6 ins. show-
ing 24 ins. above a mound of earth, scribed WC-R-2-4229,
bears N.3°11'E. 10 ft.

A cedar post 3 ins. in diameter, about 3 ft. above ground,
bearing on S. and E. faces steel signs pointing N. and W.
and marked "National Forest Boundary," bears S.53°E. 164.96
ft.

Cor. No. 1, Sur. No. 4228, Caledonia lode, the Monitor
Belmont Mining Company, claimant, bears S.72°02'10"W.
