

Mineral Survey No. 5011

FEET	<u>BILLIE THE KID LODGE</u>
	At Cor. No. 1 of the Billie the Kid lode, the point is on an East-West ridge line in a saddle on Hartford Hill. Set an aluminum post, 2 3/8 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, with aluminum cap marked BK Cor. 1 M.S. 5011. Monument is also stamped R.L.S. 1802; from which The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 8, T. 16 N., R. 21 E., M.D.M., bears N. 05° 42' 22" W., 2281.32 ft. dist. Said 1/4 sec. cor. is monumented with an unmarked 1 in. diam. pipe in a mound of rock. The corner is by reputation commonly used as the 1/4 sec. cor. No local bearing objects or bearing trees available. Thence N. 2° 46' 44" E.
524.73	Intersect line 4-5, M.S. No. 95, Green lode, at a point from which Cor. No. 5 bears N. 14° 38' 02" W., 60.86 ft. dist.
586.58	Intersect line 5-1, M.S. No. 95, Green lode, at a point from which Cor. No. 5 bears S. 81° 02' 54" W., 18.60 ft. dist.
716.12	Cor. No. 2. Set an aluminum post, 2 3/8 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, 24 ins. in the ground, with an aluminum cap marked BK Cor. 2. M.S. 5011. Monument also stamped R.L.S. 1802. No local bearing objects or bearing trees available. Thence N. 66° 51' 35" W.
212.62	Lode line; discovery point bears S. 10° 13' 17" W., 774.09 ft. dist.
425.24	Cor. No. 3. Set an aluminum post, 2 3/8 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, 4 ins. in the ground and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, with an aluminum cap marked BK Cor. 3 M.S. 5011. Monument also stamped R.L.S. 1802; from which Cor. No. 2 of M.S. No. 81 Central lode, identical with Cor. No. 3 of M.S. No. 140 Lucerne lode, bears N. 3° 07' 39" E., 87.69 ft. dist., monumented with an aluminum post, 2 3/8 ins. diam., 30 ins. long, mkd. MS 140 COR 3.
