off from here in a Southwesterly direc-
tion: A narrow Valley runs to the East-
ward of this point connecting with
the Pah-rimp-Valley. East of this
connecting Valley is a broken Range of
Mountains running in a North west &
S.E. direction, which are stratified in
layers of numerous colored rocks, giving
thereto a grand and picturesque appear-
ance.

Land up to this point level, sandy
and gravel wash.
