Rail Road I run South

Set Initial Monument - This
monument is a granite shaft from
the Sierra Nevada Mountains - 8
feet long by 18 inches square with
two feet at the top chiseled 1 foot
square and pointed - and marked
as per instructions. It is set two
feet in the ground. a mound of
stone built around it 6 feet in
diameter and 4 feet high, and pits
dug as per instructions

From this monument the
center face of a prominent bluff
of Columnar Basalt bears S 45°
15' E - about 1 mile distant
This bluff is the most prominent
