

BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN CALIFORNIA AND NEVADA.

RETRACING.

post set firmly in the ground, marked, Nev. on N. E. 1873 on S. E. Cal. on S. W. and O. 326+69 M. on N. W. faces, with pits 18 x 18 x 12 inches on line northwest and southeast of post, 6 feet distant and an earth mound around post.

The return course is, therefore, south 47° 58' east, which being practically a straight line, I adopt as the boundary connecting with temporary corners in subdividing.

Land mountainous. Soil third rate.

Dense undergrowth of greasewood.

As I find no trace of corners on line for a considerable distance in advance of this point, I run, North 47° 58' west on a random line along boundary.

Variation 17° 15' east.

I set temporary corners at each 80.00 chains and at, Arrive at a point 156 links north 42° 02' east, from the closing corner of Mount Diablo base line on state boundary, which is a post set firmly in the ground, marked C. C. T. 1 N. R. 32 E. S. 35 on W. face, with a pit 24 x 18 x 12 inches, 8 links northwest of post and an earth mound 2 feet high, 4½ feet base around post.

The return course is, therefore, south 48° 12' east, which being practically a straight line, I adopt as the boundary connecting with temporary corners in subdividing.

Land mountainous. Soil third rate.

Dense undergrowth of greasewood.
