GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land in T.19 S., R.50 E. is low, rolling, broken and rocky hills; on the westerly slopes of a small range. The drainage is westerly.

The soil is sandy, gravelly and rocky, with clayloam, generally about 3d rate.

The undergrowth is very light and consists of sage and creosote brush.

There is no evidence of any mineral activity in the town-

ship. From this point the 1/2 mile cor. bet. monuments 104 and 105 on the state boundary bears S. 46° 31' E., 8.55 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary reserved under this group.

Land, nearly level, drains NW. Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky clayloam, 3d rate. Undergrowth, creosote and sage.

At a point on the California-Nevada State Boundary which is west of the 1/4 sec. cor. on E. bdy. of frac. sec. 2.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone to top, for 1/4 sec. cor. sec. 2, with brass cap mkd.

From this point monument 104 on the California-Nevada State Boundary bears N. 46° 30' W., 85 lks. dist.; described in the official record.

At a point on the state boundary which is south of the 1/4 sec. cor. on N. bdy. of sec. 2.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for 1/4 sec. cor. sec. 2, with brass cap mkd.

From this point the 1/2 mile cor. bet. monuments 104 and 105 on the state boundary bears S. 46° 30' E., 2.11 chs. dist.; an iron post 1 in. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

There is no final test of the solar apparatus to be recorded as the bearings of the lines were checked by deflection from the line of the California-Nevada State Boundary.
