Set a Basalt stone, $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. N. and S. of stone, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base.

Set a Basalt stone, $16 \times 13 \times 12$ ins, 11 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Secs. 5, 6, 31 & 32, marked with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on N. edges, dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. in each Sec. $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth, 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base.

Land level.

Soil 2nd and 3rd rate.

Dense undergrowth of greasewood and sage.

West on a true line on S. B. of Sec. 31.
Ta. $15^{\circ} 45'$ East.
