North on a true line between sections 1-6.

Va. $16^{\circ} 30'$ East.

Descend.

10.00 Cross Gulch, 6 lks. wide, Course West and ascend.

35.00 Top of Ridge, bears E. & N. and descend.

40.00 Set a Trachyte stone $38 \times 10 \times 6$ ins., $3\frac{1}{2}$ ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on $\frac{1}{4}$ face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits

impracticable.

69.00 Cross Gulch, 6 lks. wide, Course N. W. and ascend

70.50 Cross Road, bears, E. & N.

80.00 Set a Trachyte stone $36 \times 10 \times 10$ ins. $1\frac{1}{8}$ ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 28 and 29 N. R's 65 and 66 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
