Intersect the 4th Standard Parallel North at a point 3.38 chs. East of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 33 and 34 T. 20 N. R. 41 E

which is a stone 36 x 16 x 9 ins. 24 ins. in the ground marked with 3 notch $\hookrightarrow$ on E and 3 notch $\hookleftarrow$ on W edges and mound of stone alongside.

Set a trap stone 29 x 12 x 10 ins. 20 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 3 and 4 marked C. with 3 notch $\hookrightarrow$ on E. and 3 notch $\hookleftarrow$ on W. edges, and raised a mound of stone alongside. scattering timber
