Intersect the 4th Standard Parallel North at a point 3.49 chs. East of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 32 and 33 T. 21 N. R. 41 E which is a stone 14 x 12 x 7 ins. 10 ins. in the ground marked with 4 notch $\hookrightarrow$ on E and 2 notch $\hookrightarrow$ on W edges and mound of stone alongside. Whence bears

A Nut Pine 14 ins. diam., N 65° E 93 lks. dist. marked T 21 N R. 41 E S., 33 B. T.

A Cedar 10 ins. diam., N 58° W 200 lks. dist. marked T 21 N R. 41 E S., 32 B. T.

At point of Intersection I set a trap stone 19 x 10 x 8 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 4 and 5 marked C. with 4 notch $\hookrightarrow$ on E. and 2 notch $\hookrightarrow$ on W. edges, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.
