and pits N.E. & W. & mound of Earth
I run — North on a true line between sections 34 & 35 —
Variation $17^{\circ} 48'$ East.

Ascend gradually

40.00 Set a Line stone $1'2" \times 1'2" \times 10$ ins. 8
ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W
face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a Line stone $1'6" \times 1'2" \times 8$ ins. 10 ins. in
the ground for Cor. to Secs. 26, 27, 34 & 35 marked
with 1 notch — on S. and 2 notch $\hookleftarrow$ on E. edges and
dug pits, $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. in each Sec., $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist.,
and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base
alongside Whence bears
