Abrupt descent.

39.75 Hollow, 150 ft. deep, course SE.

Abrupt ascent.

40.00 Set a granite stone, 20x7x4 ins., 15 ins. in the ground, for
¼ sec. cor., marked ¼ on N. face, and raise a mound of
stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

48.50 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.

Descend.

50.10 Head of hollow, course S.

Ascend.

52.00 Spur, projects S.

Abrupt descent.

55.00 Head of hollow, course S.

Ascend.

57.15 Spur, projects S.

Abrupt descent.

64.00 Hollow, 150 ft. deep, course SE.

Ascend.

80.00 Set a granite stone, 15x10x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for
cor. of secs. 1-2-35 and 36, marked with 1 notch on E. and
5 notches on W. edges, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft.
base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Pits impracticable.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd. rate.

No timber.
