

Subdivision of T 25 N, R 64 E.

40.00	Over level land Deposit a marked stone 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; dig pits 18/18/12 ins. N. and S. of cor. 4 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high over deposit. In S. pit drive a juniper stake, 2 ft. long, 2 ins. sq. 12 ins. in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 on the W. face and 1 on the E. face.
100.80	Intersect the 5th. Standard Parallel North at N89° 57' W, 1.21 chs. from the standard cor. of T 26 N, Rs. 64 and 65 E re-established by me July 23, 1909. Set a limestone 15/10/4 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2; marked C C on S.; with 1 groove on E. and 5 grooves on W. face; dig pits 24/18/12 ins. crosswise on each line, E. and W. 3 ft. and S. of stone, 7 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high S. of cor. Land, level. Soil, adobe and loam. 1st. rate. Sagebrush and chico. No timber. July 28, 1909.
40.00	July 29, 1909. From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of the tp., re-established by me July 25, 1909, I run N 0° 02' W bet. secs. 34 and 35 Over level land Deposit a marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; dig pits 18/18/12 ins. N. and S. of cor. 4 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high over deposit. In S. pit drive a juniper stake, 2 ft. long, 2 ins. sq. 12 ins. in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 on the W. face and 35 on the E. face.
80.00	Set a limestone 15/12/4 ins., 10 ins. in the ground for cor. secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35; marked with 1 notch on the S.
