Chains	N 0°02'W bet. secs. 2 and 3. Over level land.
40.00	Deposit a marked stone 12 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; dig pits N. and S. of cor. 4 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high over deposit. In the S. pit drive a juniper stake, 2 ft. long, 2 ins. sq. 12 ins. in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 3 on the W. face and 2 on the E. face.
100.32	Intersect the 5th. Standard Parallel North at N 89° 57' W, 1.08 chs. from the standard cor. to secs. 35 and 36, re-established by me July 23, 1909. Set a limestone 13/9/5 ins., 9 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, marked C C on S. with 2 grooves on E. and 4 grooves on W. face; dig pits 24/18/12 ins. crosswise on each line, E. and W. 3 ft., and S. of stone 7 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high S. of cor. Land, level. Soil, adobe and loam. 1st rate. Sagebrush and chico. No timber. July 29, 1909.

N. and S. of cor. 4 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high over deposit. In S. pit drive a juniper stake, 2 ft. long, 2 ins. sq. 12 ins. in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 33 on the W. face and 34 on the E. face
80.00	Set a limestone 13/11/4 ins., 9 ins. in the ground for cor. secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, marked with 1 notch on S.
