 17.20 Top of high spur, projecting north;
 descended
 28.10 Trinity Canyon and wash, 20
 lks. wide, course $N 60^{\circ} E$. ascend
 over end of spur.
 36.00 Gulch and wash, 10 lks. wide course
 $S 10^{\circ} E$; ascend.
 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long,
 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the
 ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 30
 and 31 with brass cap mtd.;

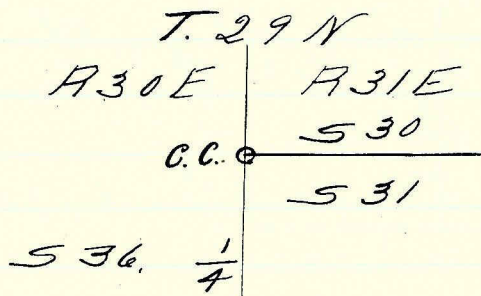
