

Subdivision of T. 29 N., R. 31 E.

Chains 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 7 and 18 with brass cap mtd.;

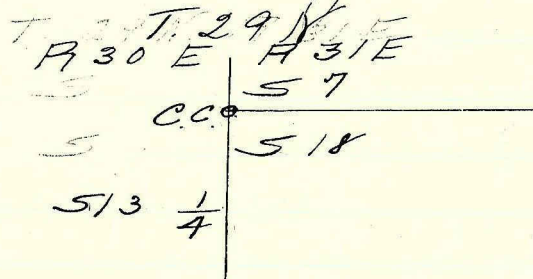
and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor. descend from low rolling ridge.

49.30 Gulch, course S, 5 Chains, thence $S 75^{\circ} E$ ascend to divide.

82.10 Top of Divide and Trinity Range, bearing $N 100^{\circ} W$ and $S 10^{\circ} E$; desc.

85.45 Intersect W. bdy. of Tp. 5.85 chs. N. of $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. sec. 13, T. 29 N., R. 30 E. Hereinafter described. At the point of intersection I build a cor. as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18 with brass cap mtd.;



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, E. of cor. Land mountainous and rough rolling Soil, rocky, 3^d rate Undergrowth, sagebrush. Timber, scattered junipers. Mountainous land, 49.85 chains. August 8, 1912

From the closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18 I run ~~Southward~~ on the W. bdy. of sec. 18.
