Chains Over rolling and mountainous land,
ascending toward divide.
40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long,
1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the
ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 6 and
7, with brass cap inscribed;
