

INVESTIGATION SURVEY, GROUP 68, NEVADA.

It will be noted that along the east boundary of T.33 N., R.34 E., there is a strip of land approximately 18 chains in width and extending the length of the east boundary which appears to be unsurveyed. The latitudinal lines of the west range of sections in T.33 N., R.35 E. were terminated at closing corners presumably set on the east boundary of T.33 N., R.34 E. The south-western closing corner of T.33 N., R.35 E., is in the position indicated on blue print number one(1) and which checks with the topography along the south boundary of section 32, also with the testimony of Mr. Peter Organ, an early resident in this locality, now residing at Mill City, Nevada. Altho none of the closing corners north of this point were identified, the topography indicates that the latitudinal lines of the west range of sections in T.33 N., R.35 E., were terminated at points nearly north of the south-west closing corner of T.33 N., R.35 E., thereby leaving an unsurveyed area as shown on the plat.

Along the west boundary of T.33 N., R.34 E., two sets of corners were identified; these corners being approximately four(4) chains apart.

The unsurveyed area on the north of T.33 N., R.34 E. is clearly shown in its relation to the surrounding surveyed sections.

A description of all original corners identified during the above retracements are herewith given:

T.33 N., R. 34 E.

Corner of secs. 23, 24, 25 & 26. Old willow stake, edges squared, no scribe marks visible. Stake about 12 inches in length, lying on surface of ground.

$\frac{1}{4}$ cor. secs. 23 & 24. Old willow stake, 18 inches in length, edges surfaced and squared, no marks, lying on surface of ground.

Cor. of Secs. 11, 12, 13 & 14. Old willow stake, 15 inches in length, edges squared, no marks, lying on surface of ground. No trace of pits or mound.

$\frac{1}{4}$ cor. secs. 11 & 12. Old willow stake, 12 inches in length, one side surfaced, no marks, lying by faint
