Undergrowth, creosote brush, greasewood.

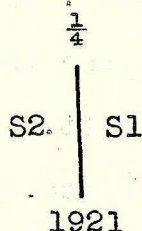
SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 16 S., R. 48 E.

S. 0°01'E., on true line, bet. secs. 1 and 2,

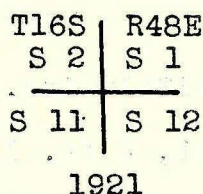
Over level desert land thru dense undergrowth,

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in
the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with
brass cap mkd:



dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of cor., 3 ft. dist

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in
the ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, with
brass cap mkd:



dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., in each sec., 3 ft. dist.

Land, level.

Soil, sandy and gravelly; 2nd to 3rd rate.

Undergrowth, creosote brush, greasewood.

East, on a random line, bet. secs. 1 and 12,

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.,

79.90 Intersect E. bdy. of Tp., 8 lks. N/ of the cor. of secs.
1, 6, 7 and 12, previously described.

Thence

N.89°57'W., on a true line, bet. secs. 1 and 12,

Over level desert land thru dense undergrowth,

39.95 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in
