

Subdivisions of T. 16 S., R. 48 E.

CHAINS

- West, on true line, bet. secs. 21 and 28,
Over level desert land thru dense undergrowth,
- 1.00 Dry wash, 30 lks. wide, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. deep, drains S.
- 11.85 Telegraph line bears N.22°40'W., and S.22°40'E.
- 12.80 Center line of T. & T. R. R. tracks bears N.22°40'W.,
and S.22°40'E.
- 22.70 Dry wash, 2 chs. wide, 6 ft. deep, drains S. Dry channel
of former Amargosa River.
- 32.60 Road, bears N.20°W., and S.20°E.
- 39.90 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in
the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 21 and 28, with
brass cap mkd:
- $$\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{4} \quad \begin{array}{c} S \quad 21 \\ S \quad 28 \end{array} \\ 1921 \end{array}$$
- dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., E. and W. of cor., 3 ft. dist
- 79.80 The cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29.
Land, level.
Soil, sandy and gravelly; 2nd rate.
Undergrowth, creosote brush, salt sage.
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- S. 0°03'E., on a true line, bet. secs. 28 and 29,
Over level desert land thru dense undergrowth,
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in
the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 28 and 29, with
brass cap mkd:
- $$\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{4} \\ S29 \quad | \quad S28 \\ 1921 \end{array}$$
- dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of cor., 3 ft. dist
- 45.00 Top of low limestone spur, bears NW. and SE.
- 65.70 Intersect Nevada-California State boundary, 4.40 chs.
S.46°37'E. of the 5 mile monument between monuments
Nos. 98 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 99, previously described, in Book "B"
At point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long,
2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for closing cor.
