Chains.	Asc. S. slope 80 ft.
46.70	Top of rocky spur, projects W. Desc. NW. slope 60 ft.
52.50	Dry wash, course SW. Asc. SW. slope 240 ft.
68.00	Top of spur, projects W. Desc. NW. slope 370 ft.
89.00	Dry wash, course NW.
91.39	Intersect the closing cor. of T. 4 N., R. 67 E., which is a granite stone, 8 x 12 x 14 ins. above ground, firmly set, mkd. CC and 6 grooves on S. face and 6 grooves on W. face, with mound of stone south.

17.50	Fall 14 lks. S. of the closing cor. of T. 4 N., R. 67 E., hereinbefore described.
39.81	Fall 33 lks. S. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., hereinafter described. The course of this $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is N. 89° 32' W. and the dist. is 39.81 chs.
79.08	Fall 42 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, hereinafter described. The course of this $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is N. 89° 52' W. and the dist. is 39.27 chs.

	From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, West, on retracement, on the S. Bdy. of sec. 35.
39.79	Intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., hereinafter described. The course of this $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is West, and the dist. 39.79 chs.
