

Dependent Resurvey of a portion of the subdivisions of T. 4 N., R. 67 E.

Chains

Land, slightly rolling. Soil, gravelly clay loam with rocky subsoil. Undergrowth, sage. Timber, juniper and pinon pine.

Survey of a portion of the subdivisions of T. 4 N., R. 67 E.

From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the E. Bdy. of the township, hereinbefore described,

West, on a true line, bet. secs. 25 and 36.

Desc. rocky SW. slope through dense juniper and pinon pine timber.

20.80 Road, 150 ft. below sec. cor., bears N. 15° E. and S. 15° W.

24.80 Dry wash, 30 ft. below road, course SW.

Desc. gradually over SW. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A juniper, 6 ins. in diam., bears N. 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 62 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S25 BT

73.01 Intersect the E. Bdy. of sec. 35, at a point, S. 1° 20' W., 1.45 chs. dist., from the cor. of sec. 35, hereinbefore described.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 25 and 36, with brass cap mkd.
