General Description.

The land included in the fragmentary survey of this township lies on the west slope of the Cedar range of mountains, approximately thirty miles north of Pioche, Nevada, at an approximate elevation of 6500 ft. The northeastern portion of the township is rough, broken and mountainous land, with numerous outcroppings of granite along the crests of ridges and spurs, which drops to choppy and broken hilly land in the central portion of the township, and finally, to gentle rolling slopes in the western and
