Chains	A juniper, 8 ins. in dia., bears S 52° 00' W, 270 lks. dist. marked T14NR51ES23BT. A juniper, 8 ins. in dia., bears N 41° 45' W, 369 lks. dist., marked T14NR51ES14BT. Land, gently rolling hills. general E exposure and drainage. Soil, rocky, 4th rate. Timber, juniper. Undergrowth, sagebrush and shadscale. Fair grazing. N 89° 59' E on a random line bet. secs. 13 and 24. 40.00 Set a temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. 79.94 Intersect the E bdy. of the Tp. at a point 02 lks. N of the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, which is a 2in. iron post, projecting about 8 ins. above ground and marked and witnessed as described in the notes of T 14 N, R 52 E. thence West on true line bet. secs. 13 and 24. Over a gentle E slope through scant undergrowth. 1.90 Shallow wash, drains SE. 26.90 Wash, 10 lks. wide and 3 ft. deep drains SE. 39.97 On a gentle E slope Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in dia., 28 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with a brass cap marked: $\begin{array}{r} S13 \\ \frac{1}{4} \text{ ---} \\ S24 \\ 1925 \end{array}$ Raise a mound of stone and earth N of the post. No trees available for marking. Desc. along a gentle SW slope 20 ft to 49.90 Wash, 20 lks. wide and 5 ft. deep, drains SE. thence over gentle E slope to sec. cor. 62.90 Old road to Indian Springs Ranch bears NW and SE. 79.94 The cor. of secs. 13, 14 23 and 24.
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
