Chains
 55.00 Point of spur, projecting E, desc. 30 ft. to,
 63.00 Draw, drains NE, asc. 40 ft. along a SE slope to,
 68.00 Spur, projects E, desc. 30 ft. over a N slope to,
 72.50 Draw, drains E, asc. 35 ft. over a S slope to,
 82.20 Intersect the Third Standard Parallel North at a point
 3,84 chains east of the standard cor. of secs. 35 and
 36, heretofore described, and at the point of inter-
 section.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 2 ins. in dia., 27 ins.
 in the ground for the closing corner of secs. 1 and 2,
 with a brass cap marked:

A pinon, 10 ins. in dia. bears S 67°30' E, 64 lks.

Land, low, rolling timbered slopes, general E exposure
 and drainage.

Soil, gravelly loam, 3rd rate.

Timber, juniper and pinon.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush and bunch grass.

Good grazing.

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 on the S
 bdy. of the Tp, described in the notes of the survey of
 T. 14 N., R. 51 E., thence.

N 0°01' W. bet sec. 34 and 35.

Over mountainous land, through scattering timber and
 scant undergrowth, asc. 45 ft. along a SW slope to,
 10.50 Spur, projects, SE, desc. 100 ft. along a NE slope to,
 24.20 Wagon road to Ross Parker's house bears NW. and SE.
