

Subdivision of T. 15 N., R. 51 E.

Chains

A pinon, 5 ins. in dia. bears N 36°30' W, 38 lks.
dist., marked: $\frac{1}{4}$ S3BT.

A mahogany, 5 ins. in dia. bears S 30°15' E, 19 lks.
dist., marked: $\frac{1}{4}$ S2BT.

Desc. 55 ft. along a NE slope to creek.

44.50 Fence, 3 strand barbed wire, bears E and W.

45.50 Number 4 Spring bears West about 1.50 chains.

46.30 Small stream from spring, about 2 lks. wide and 2 ins.
deep, good water, flows E, asc. 60 ft. along a SE
slope to spur.

48.50 Fence, 3 strand barbed wire, bears E and W.

71.40 Spur, projects E, desc. 125 ft. along NE and N slopes
to stream.

80.50 Fence, 3 strand barbed wire, bears E and W.

81.90 Small stream, good water, 2 lks. wide and 2 ins. deep,
flows E, thence along bottom of draw.

82.09 Intersect the Third Standard Parallel North at a point
3.94 chains E of the standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35,
heretofore described, and at the point of intersection
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in dia. 30 ins.
in the ground for the closing corner of secs. 2 and
3, with a brass cap marked:

From which,

A pinon, 5 ins. in dia. bears S 42°00' E, 219 lks.
dist., marked: 'CCBT' only.

No tree available for marking in section 3. No two
inch iron post available.

Land. low rolling mountains, general E exposure and
drainage.

Soil, gravelly to rocky loam, 3rd rate.

Timber, pinon and juniper.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush and bunch grass.

Good grazing.
