

Completion of subdivisions, T. 28 N., R. 22 E.

Chains.

From the closing cor. of secs. 12 and 13, on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation line, which is an iron post, firmly set and properly marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of the survey of T. 28 N., R. 22 E., within the Reservation Boundary,
East on a random line, bet. secs. 12 and 13.

19.98 Fall 7 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13, and 18, on the E. Bdy. of the township, which is an iron post, marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 28 N., R. 23 E.

Thence

S. $89^{\circ} 48'$ W. on a true line, bet. secs. 12 and 13.

Desc. gradually over gentle N. slope, over slightly rolling land.

19.98 The closing cor. of secs. 12 and 13, hereinbefore described.

Land; slightly rolling.

Soil; sandy clay of medium texture, with alkaline content.

Undergrowth; white sage and shadscale.

Very scant growth of grass.

From the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 12, on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation line, which is an iron post, marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 28 N., R. 22 E., within the Reservation Boundary,
East on a random line, bet. secs. 1 and 12.

30.13 An easting of 40.00 chs. from the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11, and 12, which is an iron post, marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 28 N., R. 22 E., within the Reservation Boundary. Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

69.81 Fall 8 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, on the E. Bdy. of the township, which is an iron post, marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 28 N., R. 23 E.

Thence

S. $89^{\circ} 56'$ W. on a true line, bet. secs. 1 and 12.
