

North Boundary of T 8 N, R 47 E.

Chains

69.50 Top of broken rock outcrop bearing N and S, continue descent over a broken and rocky E slope.

80.00 On a broken E slope:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 3 ins. in diameter, 30 ins. in the ground for the corner of townships 8 and 9 north, range 47 east, with brass cap marked:

A juniper, 16 ins. in diameter, marked BT only, bears N 30°15' E, 438 links distant.

A juniper, 18 ins. in diameter, marked BT only, bears S 16°45' E, 125 links distant.

A juniper, 6 ins. in diameter, marked T8NR47ES1BT, bears S 84°15' W, 209 links distant.

A juniper, 15 ins. in diameter, marked T9NR47ES36BT, bears N14°15' W, 230 links distant.

Land: Steep foothills, general E exposure and drainage.

Soil: Sandy to gravelly loam, 3rd rate.

Timber: Pinon and dwarf juniper.

Undergrowth: Sagebrush and buckbrush. Bunch grass.

Good grazing.

East Boundary of T 8 N, R 47 E.

Beginning at the corner of townships 8 and 9 north, range 47 east, heretofore described, a random line was surveyed south, and, at 428.86 chains, intersecting a random line projected east from the corner of township 8 north, ranges 46 and 47 east, on the township line between townships 7 and 8 north, at a point 479.09 chains east of that corner, hereinafter described; at the point of intersection:
