Chains

The survey was executed with Buff and Buff solar transit number 9222, used by Carl S. Swanholm, U. S. Cadastral Engineer and Buff and Buff solar transit number 9797, used by Robert C. Yundt, U. S. Surveyor. The survey of this fractional township was made in conjunction with that of T 8 N, R 47 E and T 8 N, R 48 E, all of the same Group, and reference is made to the official notes of the survey of those townships for the description of the instruments, method of measurement, and observations.

The entire east boundary was surveyed in connection with the survey of T 8 N, R 48 E. The major portion of the west boundary was established as the east boundary of T 8 N, R 47 E. The remaining part of the west boundary and the north and south boundaries will be recorded here.

South Boundary

Beginning at the corner of T 8 N, Rs 47½ and 48 E, an iron post 3 ins. diameter, firmly set, properly marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 8 N, R 48 E., surveyed under this group.

Thence West, along the south boundary of section 36.

Over gently sloping land, through dense sagebrush undergrowth; ascend 45 ft. along a gentle E slope to the ¼ section corner.

17.80 Wash, 6 links wide and 1 ft. deep, drains S 65° E.

40.00 On a gentle E slope:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground and in a small mound of stone, for the ¼ sec. cor. of section 36 only, with brass cap marked:

1/4 S 36

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Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, north of cor.

Ascend 35 ft. along a general E slope to the closing cor.

70.20 Wash, 3 links wide and 1 ft. deep, drains SE.

71.87 Intersect the east boundary of T 8 N, R 47 E, at a point 15.15 chains north of the ¼ section corner of section 36 T 8 N, R 47 E, an iron post, 1 in. diameter, firmly set, properly marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of T 8 N, R 47 E, surveyed under this group.

At the point of intersection:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground and in a small mound of stone, for the closing corner of T 8 N, R 47½ E, only, with brass cap marked:
