Subdivision of T 8 N, R 47½ E.

Chains

Timber: Pinon and dwarf juniper.

Undergrowth: Sagebrush. Bunch grass.

Fair grazing.

Beginning at the corner of sections 25, 30, 31, and 36 on the east boundary of the township, an iron post, 2 ins. diameter, firmly set, properly marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of T 8 N, R 48 E, surveyed under this group.

Thence

West, on true line, between sections 25 and 36.

Over gently rolling land, through a dense undergrowth of sagebrush; ascend along a rolling E slope.

8.00 Wash, 5 links wide and 1 ft. deep, drains S.

40.00 On an E slope:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground and in a small mound of stone, for ¼ section corner, with brass cap marked:

Raise a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Continue ascent over a rolling E slope.

71.85 Intersect the east boundary of T 8 N, R 47 E at a point 15.15 chains north of the ¼ section corner of section 25, an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, properly marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of T 8 N, R. 47 E, surveyed under this group.

At the point of intersection:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 25 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for closing cor. of secs. 25 and 36, T 8 N, R 47½ E, only, with brass cap mkd.

A juniper, 5 ins. diam., bears S 40°45' E, 159 links dist., marked T8NR47½ES36CCBT.

Land: Gently rolling hills; SE exposure and drainage.

Soil: Deep sandy to gravelly loam, 2nd rate.

Timber: Few widely scattered juniper.
