A juniper, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 63° E., 96 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 31 S C B T.

A pinon pine, 4 ins. diam., bears N. $13 \frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 90 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 31 S C B T.

Continue to desc. 30 ft. over S. slope.

45.60 Leave dense timber, continue through scattering timber, bears N.
and S.; desc. 50 ft. to road.

50.80 Bend in improved road, bears S. 5 lks. bears irregularly W. and S.
 40° E.

At this point, made diligent search for the original standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec.
cor., but failed to find any trace.

53.80 Improved road, bears E. and N. 70° W.

60.80 Same road, bears S. 70° W. and N. 60° E.; asc. 20 ft.

65.30 Point of spur, projects S.; desc. 40 ft.

77.56 Intersect the E. bdy. of T. 16 N., R. 48 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground,
for standard closing cor. of T. 16 N., R. 49 E., with brass cap mkd.

 $2 \frac{1}{2}$ ins. sq., 4 ft. long, firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd.
T. 16 N R 49 E S 31 on NE. face, R 48 E with 6 notches on NW.
face and SC on S face. I now destroy this cor.

From point of intersection, the cor. of secs. 24 and 25, on the E.
bdy. of T. 16 N., R. 48 E., bears S. 17.65 chs. dist., described in
the official record in book for T. 16 N., R. 48 E., under this
group.

From the same point the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on the E. bdy. of sec. 24, T.
16 N., R. 48 E., bears N. 22.35 chs. dist., described in the official
record in book of T. 16 N., R. 48 E., under this group.

Timber, juniper, pinon pine and mahogany; undergrowth, sagebrush,
squawbrush, rabbitbrush, shadscale and a fair growth of grass.
