

## SURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 15 N., R. 30 E.

## Chains

From point of intersection the standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 16 N., R. 30 E., which is an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the Resurvey of the Third Standard Parallel North, executed under this group, bears West 16.82 chs. dist.

Land, rolling W. slope.

Soil, rocky and gravelly; 4th rate.

No timber; undergrowth, shadscale, greasewood, sagebrush, squaw brush and grass.

Grazing, fair.

## SUBDIVISION OF T. 15 N., R. 30 E.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., which is an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 14 N., R. 30 E., executed under this group.

Thence

N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over rolling land through medium dense undergrowth.

4.70 Wash, course S. 70° W.

12.00 Wash, course W., faint road in wash, bears E. & W.

17.90 Begin to asc. 110 ft. over S. slope.

39.20 Sandy spur, slopes N. 70° W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 29 ins. in the ground, with a rock 3x4x5 ins. mkd. X, deposited at the base, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
