42.20	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SW.
54.00	Crest of spur, slopes SW.
72.50	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SW.
76.30	Point of spur, slopes SW.
80.02	Point for the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T4N R67E S30 S29 S31 S32 1957 from which A juniper, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 45° E., 78 lks. dist., mkd. T4N R67E S31 BT. No other bearing trees suitable for marking. Land, gently rolling hills, general SW. drainage. Soil, sandy loam, gravelly. Timber, scattered juniper. Undergrowth, sagebrush.
	West, bet. secs. 30 and 31. Over gently rolling hills, through scattered timber.
18.00	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SW.
26.10	Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SW.
40.00	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 30 and 31. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T4N R67E ¼ S30 S31 1957 from which A juniper, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 19° 45' W., 48 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S31 BT. A juniper, 4 ins. diam., bears N. 53° E., 114 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S30 BT.
43.30	Wash, 30 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SW.
72.73	Intersect the E. bdy. of T. 4 N., R. 66 E. Point for the closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
