

EAST BOUNDARY T. 26 N., R. 41 E.

Chains	Raise a supporting mound of stone, 4 ft. base, around post to top. Land, gently rolling S. and SE. slope. Soil, sandy, gravelly, and rocky light claylike loam. No timber. Undergrowth, white sagebrush.
40.00	North, along the E. bdy. of sec. 25. Ascend 90 ft. along gentle SE. slope; through sagebrush. Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 25. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 25 1948 Raise a supporting mound of stone, 4 ft. base, around post to top. Ascend 90 ft. along SE. slope.
45.00	Abandoned road, bears N. 5° W. and S. 20° E.
80.00	Point for the cor. of secs. 24 and 25. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, with brass cap mkd. T26N S 24 S 25 R41E 1948 from which A juniper, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 19$\frac{1}{4}$° W., 147 lks. dist., mkd. T26N R41E S24 BT. This is the only tree in a half mile radius. Cor. is on right bank of a ravine, 10 ft. wide and 3 ft. deep, course S. 15° E., about 4 chs., then S. 2° E. Land, slightly rolling, general SE. slope. Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky clay loam, 3d and 4th rate. No timber. Undergrowth, sagebrush.

	From the stan. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on S. bdy. of the Tp. N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36. Ascend 70 ft. on gentle SE. slope, thru sagebrush.
