40.40	Fence, 4 strand barb-wire, bears NE and SW.
41.80	Trail road, bears N. 30° E. and S. 75° W.
45.70	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains irregularly S. 40° E., leave brush; enter alfalfa field.
80.34	The cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30.
	Land, nearly level. Soil, sandy clay. Brush, 45.70 chs. Alfalfa, 34.64 chs. Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood, shadscale and alfalfa.
	N. 87° 55' W., bet. secs. 19 and 30.
	Over nearly level land, through alfalfa field.
19.62	Fence, 6 strand barb-wire, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W., leave alfalfa field.
19.90	Gravel road, bears N. and S. 20° W.
21.80	Gravel pit, 3.00 chs. diam.
28.10	Corral fence, 3 strand barb-wire, with net wire, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W., R.E.A. powerline, bears same.
34.20	R.E.A. powerline, bears S. 10° E. and N. 10° W.
36.80	Corral fence, 3 strand barb-wire with net wire, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W., leave corrals; enter alfalfa field.
40.14	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 30, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 15 ins. underground with no cap. from which: An iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, with a collar of stone, for a reference monument, bears S. 87° 55' E., 3.393 chs. dist., with brass cap mkd., T. 43N., R. 32 E. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 19 S 30 RM 223.9 ft., 1962 and an arrow pointing to the cor.
60.40	Fence, 6 strand barb-wire, bears SE. and NW.
60.50	Graded road, bears SE. and NW.
60.90	Canal, 20 lks. wide, drains SE.
78.78	The cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30 on the W. bdy., of the Tp., monumented with a copperweld, set, mkd., and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of T. 43 N., R. 31 E. Land, nearly level. Soil, sandy clay. Corrals, 16.80 chs. Alfalfa, 61.98 chs. Undergrowth, alfalfa.
