

Township 3 South, Range 35 East, M.D.M., Nevada

The North, East and fractional South boundary and the subdivis-
ional lines of the east 4 ranges of sections were surveyed by
Deputy Surveyors Hatch, Barker and Eaton in 1877. The South
boundary and subdivisional lines were closed against the Nevada-
California boundary surveyed by A. W. Von Schmidt, Astronomer and
Surveyor, in 1873. These surveys are shown on the plat of T. 3 S.,
R. 35 E., M.D.M., Nevada, approved November 6, 1877.

An independent resurvey of the Nevada-California state boundary
made by the Coast and Geodetic Survey in 1898-99 is located approx-
imately one half mile to the southwest of the Von Schmidt 1873
boundary.

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey
of the North, East and fractional South boundary and of certain
subdivisional lines of T. 3 S., R. 35 E., M.D.M., Nevada, the
survey of the South boundary from the Von Schmidt to the Coast
and Geodetic state lines, ~~and the survey of those subdivisional
lines completing the survey of those portions of secs. 16, 22, 26
and 36 situated between the two state lines.~~

The resurvey and survey herein described was executed with
Buff & Buff light mountain solar tranist No. 23817. Pertinent
preliminary information is given in the field notes of T. 4 S.,
R. 36 E., resurveyed and surveyed under this assignment.

The directions of the lines were determined by deflection from
an azimuth determined by an hour angle observation on Polaris, at
the SE. cor. of the township, as described in the field notes of
T. 4 S., R. 36 E., and checked by deflection from each other.

The geographical position of the SE. cor. of the Township is:

Latitude: 37° 37.6' N. Longitude: 118° 01.8' W.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF E. BDY., T. 3 S., R. 35 E.

Chains

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by Hatch,
Barker and Eaton, Deputy Surveyors, in 1877.

Beginning at the cor. of Ts. 3 and 4 S., Rs. 35 and 36 E., which
is monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, marked and
witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey and
survey of T. 4 S., R. 36 E., under this assignment.

From this corner, the triangulation station on White
Mountain Peak bears N. 87° 58' W..

N. 0° 03' W., bet. secs. 31 and 36. (S½ mile).

Over level land covered with sand and clay hummocks, thru soapweed
or greasewood and some sagebrush.

The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, which is monumented with a
lava stone, 13 x 12 x 8 ins. above ground, mkd. ¼ on W. side.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the
ground, with brass cap mkd.
