Chains	Soil, alkaline clay loam and sand, 2d rate. Undergrowth, greasewood, soapweed, sagebrush, etc. No timber.
37.08	West, bet. secs. 2 and 35. Over level land, thru low undergrowth. Intersect the California-Nevada state boundary. Point for closing cor. of Ts. 3 and 4 S., R. 35 E. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground with brass cap mkd. 1953 Raise a flat mound of stone, 4 ft. base, around post to top. From this point Monument No. 67½ bears N. 47° 34' W., 2.17 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the portion of the California-Nevada state boundary resurveyed under this assignment. Land, level. Soil, alkaline clay loam and sandy, 2d rate. Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood, soapweed, etc. No timber.

12.22	Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by Hatch, Barker and Eaton, Deputy Surveyors, in 1877, to the Von Schmidt state line. From the closing cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the Von Schmidt state line, described in the field notes of the portion of the Von Schmidt state line retraced under this assignment. N. 0° 19' E., bet. secs. 35 and 36, with new measurement. Over level land, thru heavy undergrowth. Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at proportionate distance. Find no evidence of the original cor. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd.
