

Independent Resurvey and Survey, W. Bdy. of T. 4 S., R. 36 E.

Chains

44.15 Nevada State Highway No. 3A, bears N.39°25'W. and S.39°25'E., about 1/2 mile to Dyer Post Office. Newly graded and oiled. Ascend 45 ft. on gentle NE. slope.

46.90 Abandoned old road, bears parallel to new highway.

80.00 Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a flat mound of stone, 4 ft. base, around post to top.

Land, nearly level bottom land, N½; gentle NE. slope, S½.
Soil, alkaline clay loam and sandy, N½; clay loam, sand, gravelly and occasionally rocky, S½. 1st to 3d rate.
Undergrowth, greasewood, soapweed, sagebrush, etc.
Grazing, poor.

South, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

Ascend 60 ft. over rocky, washed NE. slope, thru low brush.

6.30 Wash channel, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course N.50°E.

13.00 Wash channel, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course N.55°E.

27.69 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary line.

Point for closing cor. of Ts. 4 S., Rs. 35 and 36 E.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a flat mound of stone, 4 ft. base, around post to top.

From point of intersection the 2 mile cor. from Monument 67½ bears N.47°34'W., 1.36 chs. dist., and Monument 68 bears S.47°34'E., 5.57 chs. dist., both monuments described in the field notes of the Portion of the California-Nevada state boundary concurrently resurveyed.

Land, gentle NE. slope of Fish Lake Valley.
Soil, alkaline clay loam, sand, gravel and rock, 3d rate.
Undergrowth, light sagebrush and desert growth.
Grazing, poor.
