

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF PORTION OF WEST BOUNDARY, T. 4 S., R. 36 E.

Chains	T4S R35E R36E 3 6 S 7 1953 Bury the old stake alongside the iron post, and raise a flat mound of stone, 4 ft. base, around post to top. Land, gradual NE. slope of Fish Lake Valley. Soil, sand, gravel and occasional granite rocks. Undergrowth, very light sagebrush and desert growth; Grazing, poor.
6.67	W. 1° 42' W., along the W. bdy. of sec. 6. Descend gentle NE. slope, through light undergrowth. Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary. Point for closing cor. of Tps. 4 S., Rs. 35 and 36 E. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked NEV C C S 1 S 6 R35E R36E T4S 1953 Raise a flat mound of stone, 4 ft. base around post to top. From this point Monument No. 67½ bears N. 47° 34' W., 18.08 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this assignment. Continue measurement on a blank line.
9.40	Rut road, bears NE. and SW.
40.00	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6 at record distance; find no evidence of the original corner.
69.47	Point for the former closing cor. of Tps. 4 S., Rs. 35 and 36 E., at proportionate distance on the Von Schmidt State Line, described in the field notes of the portion of the Von Schmidt State Line retraced under this assignment. Find no evidence of the original cor.
