

Dependent Resurvey of the West Boundary of T. 15 N., R. 22 E.

Chains	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. T15N R21E S 1 S12 1950 from which A juniper, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $42\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 47 lks. dist., mkd. T15N R21E S12 BT. A juniper, 6 ins. diam., bears N. $31\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 60 lks. dist., mkd. T15N R21E S1 BT. 79.82 The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, marked by the original monument, a slate stone, 14x8x6 ins., loosely set in a small mound of stone, marked with 5 grooves on S. and 1 groove on N. face. This cor. is now altered and refers only to the cor. of secs. 6 and 7, T. 15 N., R. 22 E. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. T15N R22E S 6 S 7 1950 Bury the original corner stone alongside the iron post. from which A juniper, 7 ins. diam., bears N. $17\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 100 lks. dist., mkd. T15N R22E S6 BT. Land, rough broken rocky mountainous. Soil, sandy, with considerable sliderock, outcrops and ledges Timber, pinon pine and juniper. Undergrowth, sagebrush, jointfir and rabbitbrush.
	N. $0^{\circ} 50'$ W., along the W. bdy. of sec. 6. Over mountainous land, through scattering mixed timber and dense undergrowth; ascend 60 ft. along a SE. slope. 8.00 Point of spur, projects N. 60° E.; descend 80 ft. along a NW. slope. 11.40 Ravine, 8 lks. wide, course N. 30° E.; ascend 32 ft. along a SE. slope. 14.00 Point of spur, projects E.; ascend 22 ft. 19.50 Head of ravine; course SE.; ascend 15 ft. 23.00 A long spur, slopes N. 80° E.; descend 130 ft. along a N. slope. 30.60 Ravine, 24 lks. wide, at junction, from S. 75° W. and NW.; course East; ascend 150 ft. along SE. slope.
