

Dependent Resurvey of the West Boundary of
T. 35 N., R. 62 E.

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Reestablishment of surveys executed by Hatch and Eaton,
Deputy Surveyors, in 1870.

Beginning at the cor. of Tps. 34 and 35 N., Rs. 61 and
62 E., an iron post, 3 ins. diam., described in the
field notes of the Resurvey of T. 34 N., R. 62 E.,
executed under this same group.

Thence

N. 0° 09' W., bet. secs. 31 and 36. (S. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile.)

Over nearly level land, through willows.

0.90 Leave willows, bear E. and W.; across hay meadow.

4.30 Slough, dry, course E.

8.50 Enter willows, bear E. and W.

9.20 Wash, course E.

9.65 Fence, bears E. and W.; leave willows, bear E. and W.;
across meadow.

21.60 Creek, course E.

40.30 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; the testimony of Robert Steele,
owner of the land to the south, and a resident of the
vicinity since approximately 1873, and of Ray Goodwin,
owner of the land to the north, indicates the fence,
which bears E. and W., was built from the then extant
original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.; the latitudinal position of the
 $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. is determined from the position of the
fence.

At point for corner, in fence, bears E. and W.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in
the ground, with a granite stone, 4x4x6 ins., mkd. with
a cross (X), deposited at base, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with
brass cap mkd.

N. 0° 09' W., bet. secs. 31 and 36. (N. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile.)

Across nearly level field.

39.86 At intersection with fence, originally constructed E.
and W. from the then extant original corner of
secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, according to the testimony
of Ray Goodwin, owner of the land to the N and S. and
Robert Steele, a resident of the vicinity since 1873,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in
the ground, with a granite stone, 3x4x5 ins., mkd. with
a cross (X), deposited at base, for cor. of secs. 25,
30 31 and 36, with brass cap mkd.
