N. 0° 10' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over rolling land.

17.20 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, drains NE.

29.20 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains NE.

39.88 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at propor-
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the
original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in
the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
