	Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.
9.10	Nevada Northern Railroad, bears N. 14° E. and S. 14° W.
11.60	Telephone line, bears N. 14° E. and S. 14° W.
40.34	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T26N R64E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 S 1 1966 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.
80.78	The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 27 N., R. 64 E., executed concurrently under this same group. Land, nearly level. Soil, sandy clay. Undergrowth, sagebrush and native grasses.
	From the standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of the Tp. N. 0° 31' E., bet. secs. 34 and 35. Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.
40.39	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 34 and 35, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T26N R64E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 S 35 1966 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.
41.00	Enter meadow land, edge bears NE. and SW.
65.00	Nevada Northern Railroad, bears N. 14° E. and S. 14° W.
68.40	Telephone line, bears N. 14° E. and S. 14° W.
