

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF T. 26 N., R. 64 E.

CHAINS

- From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.
- S. 89° 52' W., bet. secs. 3 and 10.
- Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.
- 40.26 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 10, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.
- 24.50 Trail road, bears NNE. and SSW.
- 40.56 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
