41.30	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T27N R64E $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{S}{S}$ $\frac{6}{7}$ 1966 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.
82.42	The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, on the W. bdy. of the Tp. Land, gently rolling. Soil, sandy clay. Undergrowth, sagebrush and native grasses.
40.55	From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8. NORTH, bet. secs. 5 and 6. Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth.
