	From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp. N. $0^{\circ} 01' W.$, bet. secs. 35 and 36. Over nearly level land, through medium dense undergrowth; desc. 40 ft. over a gentle N. slope to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
1.80	Highway water diversion channel, 20 lks. wide, 6 ft. deep, parallels highway, drains W.
3.50	U. S. Highway No. 50, bears N. $84\frac{3}{4}^{\circ} E.$ and S. $84\frac{3}{4}^{\circ} W.$
