

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 7 N., R. 26 E.

CHAINS	
56.50	Right bank of river, bears NNE. and SSW.; asc. 330 ft. over a NW. slope, through medium brush.
71.00	Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 120 ft. over a SE. slope.
80.60	The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, marked and witnessed as described in the field note record of the west boundary of T. 7 N., R. 27 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same group.
	Land, rolling to bottom land. Soil, rocky clay and sandy clay loam. Vegetation, shadscale, sagebrush and buckthorn.
	From the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.
	N. 89° 15' W., bet. secs. 26 and 35.
	Over rolling hills, through medium brush; asc. 100 ft. over a NE. slope.
6.00	Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 220 ft. over a NW. slope.
33.20	Enter river bottom, edge bears NE. and SW.; this land is subject to overflow during periods of high water.
37.70	Left bank of present channel of East Walker River, bears N. and SW.; thence across river, course SW.
39.40	Right bank of present river channel, bears N. and SW.; continue over bottom land.
39.99	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 26 and 35, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.
	Continue over bottom land.
44.50	Right bank of old river channel, bears NE. and SW.; asc. 270 ft. over a SE. slope.
45.40	Trail road, bears NE. and SW.
