

RETRACEMENT OF THE NEVADA-CALIFORNIA STATE LINE
BETWEEN MILE POST NOS. 91 and 93

CHAINS	
	Mile Post No. 91, monumented with a scoria stone, 18x6x6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with MP 91 1872 on the N. face, NEV on the E. face, CAL on the W. face, and L 120 on the S. face. At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 8 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. MP 91 CAL NEV 1972 deposit the original corner stone alongside the iron post. S. 0° 28' E., along the 92nd mile. Over mountainous land, covered with sagebrush and bunch-grass; desc. 410 ft. over SW. slope. 22.00 Ravine, drains SE.; asc. 110 ft. along E. slope. 27.21 The closing corner of Tps. 32 and 32½ N., R. 17 E., hereinafter described. 72.00 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 40 ft. along E. slope. 80.04 Mile Post No. 92, monumented with a scoria stone, 15x12x8 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 92 M on the N. face, NEV. on the E. face, CAL on the W. face, and L 120 1872 on the S. face. At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 8 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. MP 92 CAL NEV 1972 deposit the original corner stone alongside the iron post. S. 0° 33' E., along the 93rd mile. Over mountainous land, covered with sagebrush and bunch-grass; desc. 10 ft. along E. slope. 14.00 Rim rock, bears E. and W.; desc. 440 ft. over S. slope changing to SW.
