	Retracement of the Survey Executed by A. W. Von Schmidt, U. S. Astronomer and Surveyor, in 1872 Mile Post No. 84, monumented with a wooden post, 8 ins. square, 5 ft. long, loosely set in a mound of stone and earth, mkd. CAL on the W. face, NEV on the E. face, 1872 on the S. face and illegible scribe marks on the N. face. At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. MP 84 CAL NEV 1973 reset the original wooden post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 5 ft. base, 4 ft. high, S. of cor. S. 0° 17' E., along the 85th Mile. Over rolling land, covered with sagebrush and bunchgrass. 24.00 Enter Painter Flat; edge bears SE. and WNW. 31.87 The closing cor. of Tps. 33 and 33½ N., R. 18 E., hereinafter described. 80.22 Mile Post No. 85, monumented with a wooden post, 6 ins. square, 6 ft. long, loosely set in a mound of earth, mkd. CAL on the W. face, NEV on the E. face, 85 M on the N. face and illegible scribe marks on the S. face. At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. MP 85 CAL NEV 1973 reset the original wooden post and set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, alongside the iron post.
